Information for PTF – scholars attending XV ISAH 2011

This compilation gives you information about

- how to get from the airport to congress venue / your accommodation
- regarding your accommodation arrangements
- what meetings to attend and where
- financial matters

How to get from the airport to congress venue / your accommodation

Vienna International Airport is about 16 km east of Vienna in Schwechat. There are three main options for getting from the airport to Vienna city centre: the bus, the train or a taxi. Find more information on the various transportation services in the **Annex**.

Use line to Kaisermühlen - VIC - Kagran	Use line to Westbahnhof
Change at “Kagran” into bus line 27A and get off at “Josef Baumanngasse 8 / Veterinärmedizinische Universität”	Change into U3 and get off at “Volkstheater” Go 1 stop with tram line 46
Arriving by bus CAT or S7	
At “Wien Mitte / Landstraße” change into metro line U4 and go 1 stop to “Schwedenplatz” and change to U1	At “Wien Mitte / Landstraße” change into metro line U3 and and get off at “Volkstheater”
Change at “Kagran” into bus line 27A and get off at “Josef Baumanngasse 8 / Veterinärmedizinische Universität”	Go 1 stop with tram line 46, walk to Lerchenfelderstraße 1-3

Arrival:

The student dorm is located opposite the main gate of the campus of the University for Veterinary Medicine, which is also the congress venue.

Arriving outside the general office hours (normally 8:30am-4pm) please go to the University Campus Main gate and talk to the main gate security guard. The guard will hand out to you an envelope signed with your name containing your room number and the keys to your room.

Accommodation:

All your rooms are equipped with a bathroom, a refrigerator and a kitchenette. A department store is right around the corner, as are restaurants and the university cafeteria.

Clean bed sheets are provided, but you have to bring along your own bath towels.

Please do not leave the keys in the lock when leaving the room. When the door is shut, you may not be able to return anymore.

The dorm will be closed during night hours, so if you plan to return late in the night, carry the keys with you. There is no janitor at the dorm during night hours to open for you, in case you happen to have no keys with you.

Compensation for lost keys will be 100EUR.

Payment:

The PTF covers your room costs for the duration of July 2 – 9. For every extra day arriving earlier or departing later than that you will be charged 20 EUR / night.

Rooms are charged per person & night, so if you share your room with someone you can't divide the costs among you.

The extra costs have to be paid during the PTF meeting on Wednesday evening in EUR cash to the congress secretariat.

Departure:

Upon departure, you just lock up your room and deposit the keys in the Mail box reading Verwaltung/Office in the entrance hall, ground floor.

Arrival and Departure

You check-in and out as in any regular in hotel. HOTEL ATLAS is located in immediate vicinity of the city centre, just behind the Parliament. Public transport facilities (tram 46; underground U2 and U3), the Ringstrasse and Museumsquartier are within easy reach.

The rooms come with bath/WC, telephone, internet access, SAT-TV.

Payment:

The PTF covers your room costs for the duration of July 2 – 9. For every extra day arriving earlier or departing later than that you will be charged 37 EUR / night. You have also to bear the costs for your room mate.

You pay your extra costs as in any regular hotel upon checking out in EUR cash or by credit card.

The main sponsors of PTF will present themselves in this meeting. You will also get your travel reimbursement at the end of the meeting to a max. of 700EUR. You will also have to settle open accommodation dues to the student dorm, if so arising. Please have the proper amount of EUR cash ready for paying your extra accommodation costs. PTF scholars residing in Hotel Atlas settle their extra costs directly with Hotel Atlas.

Other Social Events

PTF scholars are free to come along to all Social Events of XV ISAH 2011. The costs for the congress banquet will be covered for you by the PTF.

ANNEX

Schwechat Airport – Vienna by bus

The bus service from the **airport to Vienna** operated by **Vienna Airport Lines** is the best value option but also take the longest. Depending on the level of traffic it usually takes about forty five minutes from the airport to center.

Airport ↔ Wien Mitte / Landstraße

- Travel time: 16 minutes
- Frequency: every 30 minutes
- Operating hours:
 - **Wien Mitte/Landstraße → Airport**, daily from 5.38 am - 11.08 pm
 - **Airport → Wien Mitte/Landstraße**, daily from 6.05 am - 11.35 pm
- Rates:
 - **One way: €10.00**, online rate: €9.00
 - **Return: €18.00**, online rate: €16.00
 - **Children up to 14 years travel on the CAT free of charge.**

You can buy your **CAT ticket** online, from ticket machines and from tourist information at the airport. Passengers can complete check-in and receive their boarding cards for many flights at Wien Mitte, when checking in for the CAT.

Express train S7

These trains run much more slowly than the CAT but are also **much cheaper**.

- **Airport ↔ Wien Mitte/Landstrasse**
Stops in Vienna: Kaiserebersdorf, Zentralfriedhof S-Bahn, Geiselbergstraße, St. Marx, Rennweg, Wien Mitte Landstrasse, Praterstern, Traisengasse, Handelskai, Floridsdorf
- Travel time from/to Wien Mitte/Landstrasse: 26 minutes
Operating hours:
Wien Mitte/Landstraße → Airport, daily from 4.31 am - 11.46 pm
Airport → Wien Mitte/Landstraße, daily from 5.24 am to 0.18 am
Timetables for all stations are available at www.oebb.at
Frequency: mostly every 30 minutes
- Rates:
One way tickets: €3.60 in advance and at ticket machines. Each passenger needs two tickets of €1.80 each. Validate both tickets before boarding. The one way tickets can be purchased from tourist information at the airport and from ticket machines in Vienna and at the airport.

Schwechat Airport – Vienna by taxi

For those with large suitcases and deep pockets there is no doubt, that the simplest way into town is by taxi. Be warned, however, to ensure to hire an official taxi and that the driver uses the meter. There have been instances of unlicensed drivers quoting very low prices to unsuspecting tourists and then adding extortionate extras on at the destination. There are booking desks in the arrival halls and the contact information of licensed companies is available as well. The fare depends on the destination in Vienna and is approx. 30 - 40 €.

Airport Driver

The taxi service of **Airport Driver** takes you from the airport directly to your destination in Vienna or from anywhere in Vienna directly to the airport for a fixed fare of 31 EUR. You can pay by cash or credit card.
